






Optical Cable Connections

SIRMB Plug



Use a pick tool to press the blue lock down from the side illustrated above and remove lock.

Factory Plug




On the Factory Plug, repeat previous step (Remove Lock)

Factory Plug




Lift tab up to allow the Fiber Optic Lead to slide out of the factory plug on the Output side.

Factory Plug




Insert Optical lead from the input SIRMB Connector into the Output Connector of the Factory Connector (↑ to ↓).

Take the Optical leads that you've just removed from the output of the Factory Connector and insert in into the output of the SIRMB Connector

Installation general:

Install Interface in the Dash behind Radio and connect the optical cable to interface and radio, connect the power harness Black wire to ground and the Yellow wire to +12V constant power. Install the Sirius tuner in the Dash, possibly on the passenger side of the vehicle where there is sufficient room to install the module. You may need to place the satellite antenna in different places in the vehicle to check the signal level before permanently mounting the antenna.

Operating Instructions:

To Activate Sirius Radio, press the **SAT** button on the radio.

To navigate the Sirius Radio use the **Transport** buttons on the radio. **Left** and **Right** to change Genres and the **Up** and **Down** buttons to change channels. Pressing the Info button on the radio will display the Channel name Artist and Song title on the screen.

Pressing the Scan button on the radio will cause the radio to scan a new channel every 10 seconds in the current genre.

You may also store your favorite channels in the radio **Presets**. Have the channel you wish to store active on the radio and then press the **Presets** button on the radio and then press the number either 1 – 6 on the number pad and hold until the channel name appears by the corresponding number on the radio display. To select the stored preset press the **Presets** button and press the corresponding number on the number pad and the tuner will change to that preset channel.
